I believe this initiative aligns closely with the mission and objectives of our programs, and I am committed to working collaboratively to ensure its success.

I look forward to the opportunity to continue working together with Church at the Park once the shelter site is opened. We are already partnering with two C@P outreach staff on a weekly basis to help those in our programs with the next steps they need, including helping people transition into one of the Salem facilities as needed. It would be a huge step in the right direction to be able to offer this transitional shelter in our own community, so that those who are already unsheltered here can stay connected to the support and surroundings they're already familiar with.
