

Rules of Operation

- 1. **Only authorized Safe Parkers may stay at designated Safe Parking host sites.** All Safe Parking participants must apply through the C@P website. The Safe Parking Coordinator will screen, approve, and assign a safe parking location to the participant. Participants staying in each vehicle must sign and abide by C@P's Safe Parking Participant Agreement.
- 2. **Hours of Operation:** Overnight Parking: Safe Parking participants may stay at the Safe Parking site from 7pm to 7am, 7 days a week. Host sites may request specific days to pause Safe Parking to accommodate events. This must be communicated to C@P and all Safe Parking participants 48 hours in advance. All-Hour Parking: If a host site permits all-hour parking, designated Safe Parking participants may stay on the site 24/7.
- 3. **Safe Parking participants must sleep inside vehicles only.** No tent camping or improvised camping is authorized.
- 4. **Vehicle Breakdowns:** Vehicles must be in working condition. In the event that a vehicle cannot be moved off the Safe Parking site, the driver must immediately notify the Safe Parking Coordinator.
- 5. **Restroom:** It is the responsibility of each safe parking participant to help keep the portable restroom clean. The portable restroom will be emptied and professionally cleaned every week.
- 6. **Garbage:** A garbage receptacle is provided for participants. Participants will properly dispose of all trash in the designated receptacle. Each participant must use the garbage receptacle as intended and help keep the site clean.
- 7. **Personal property:** All personal property must be managed and stored in compliance with SRC Chapter 50 property maintenance.
- 8. No illegal drugs or alcohol are allowed on the property at any time.
- 9. **Meals & Cooking:** No open flames are allowed on the property or in the participant's vehicle.
- 10. **Noise Regulations:** Residents will conduct themselves in a courteous and responsible manner at all times, and will limit noise levels to allow other residents to rest in their own vehicles.
